


How to Access i-Ready at Home For Students and Parents

Purpose: This set of instructions is for students who want to access i-Ready at home on any **non-iPad device** (i.e., desktop computer, laptop, tablet). Please note, if students want to access i-Ready on an iPad please see our *i-Ready Single Sign-On iPad Instructions*.

1. Log in to **MyCNUSD** using the following link <https://my.cnusd.k12.ca.us/>



2. Depending on the grade level, select the following options from the **MyCNUSD** page:



3. Now that you are logged into your students i-Ready account, there will be two sides of the screen. **Teacher Assigned** on the left, and **My Path** on the right.

Click onto the **My Path** to take your ELA & Math Diagnostics. Click on **Teacher Assigned** to take any lesson your teacher has assigned your student for remediation or practice from classroom lessons.

The **Teacher Assigned** path is for current math work being done in class and is assigned by the teacher.



The **My Path** is based on your students most recent diagnostic test (this was given the first couple weeks of school). All students are assigned lessons in My Path which helps with previous years math content that they are not proficient with, and/or it will push your student to learn past where they are at. The goal is for students to spend 30-60 minutes per week in the My Path area.
